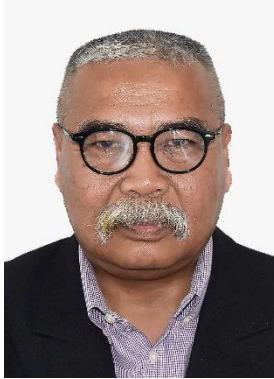

Asisten Komisioner Polis Bersara (ACP Bersara) Ramli Bin Dato' Mohd Nor dilahirkan pada 01hb Oktober tahun 1958 di Penempatan Orang Asli Batu 12, Jalan Pahang, Gombak, Selangor. Ayahanda beliau berketurunan Orang Asli Semenanjung dari suku kaum Semai, Cameron Highland, Pahang manakala bondanya suku kaum Termiar, Gua Musang Kelantan. Beliau merupakan Pegawai Kanan Polis berketurunan Orang Asli Semenanjung yang menyandang pangkat tertinggi dalam perkhidmatan Polis Diraja Malaysia buat ketika ini. Beliau telah bersara wajib daripada perkhidmatan Polis DiRaja Malaysia pada tarikh 01 Oktober 2018.

Dari sudut akademiknya, ketika ini beliau sedang mengikuti program di peringkat falsafah kedoktoran (PhD) dalam bidang perniagaan di Universiti Antarabangsa Malaya-Wales (IUMW), kelulusan akademik lain yang beliau miliki adalah Master in Public Administration dengan Kepujian dari Universiti Terbuka Malaysia (OUM) dan penerima Anugerah Canselor OUM tahun 2014, Sarjana Muda Kelas Pertama, Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Business Studies, University of East London, London UK, Diploma Sains KePOLISan, Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM), Diploma in Public Administration, Institut Teknologi Mara (ITM), Certificate in Criminal Justice Education, University of Virginia, USA dan lulusan Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) National Academy Graduate 244th Session, Quantico, Virginia USA.

ACP Bersara Ramli Bin Dato' Mohd Nor mempunyai tiga puluh empat tahun pengalaman dalam perkhidmatan PDRM. Perkhidmatannya di dalam perkhidmatan awam, merangkumi empat tahun bersama Lembaga Pelabuhan Johor Sebagai Pegawai Trafik Pelabuhan dan tiga puluh empat tahun sebagai Pegawai Kanan dalam Pasukan Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM). Beliau mempunyai pengalaman yang luas dalam hal ehwal pengurusan perkhidmatan awam terutama sekali dalam bidang operasi pelabuhan semasa berkhidmat dengan Lembaga Pelabuhan Johor, serta bidang siasatan, pendakwaan, latihan dan pengurusan dalam perkhidmatan PDRM. Pada keseluruhannya telah berkhidmat selama tiga puluh lapan tahun dalam perkhidmatan kerajaan sebelum bersara wajib.

Dari 1980 sehingga 1984, sebagai Pegawai Trafik Lembaga Pelabuhan Johor, beliau turut bertanggungjawab mengendalikan hal ehwal import dan eksport barangan dagangan (termasuk kontena) di dalam pelabuhan yang merangkumi tugas pemunggahan barang dagangan yang turun dan naik kapal beserta penyimpanan barang tersebut di dalam gudang pelabuhan.

Kerjaya beliau sebagai Pegawai Kanan Polis bermula pada tahun 1984. Sepanjang perkhidmatannya dalam PDRM, beliau pernah menjalani tugas-tugas kepolisan yang merangkumi pengurusan, latihan, siasatan, pendakwaan serta perhubungan awam. Perkembangan perkhidmatan beliau selama 34 tahun dalam PDRM telah membawa beliau mencapai kenaikan pangkat sehingga ACP pada Oktober, 2015.

Setelah tamat latihan asas Inspektor, beliau memulakan tugas sebagai Pegawai Penyiasat Jenayah dan Trafik di Daerah Polis Tampin, Negeri Sembilan sebelum bertukar ke Daerah Polis Gombak, Selangor pada 1987. Berikutan itu beliau telah diamanahkan untuk melaksanakan tugas sebagai Pegawai Pendakwa Mahkamah di Mahkamah Majlisret Rawang sehingga 1994. Selanjutnya, dari 1994 sehingga 1996 dengan pangkat Ketua Inspektor beliau telah diamanahkan untuk menjalankan tugas sebagai Pegawai Penyiasat Kanan Jenayah, Daerah Polis Gombak, Selangor.

Tahun 1996, beliau telah dinaikkan pangkat ke Assistant Superintenden Polis (ASP) dan telah ditugaskan sebagai ASP Penyelaras Pentadbiran di Jabatan Pengurusan Bukit Aman, Kuala Lumpur. Pada 2000, beliau telah ditukarkan ke Kontinjen Polis Kuala Lumpur dengan memegang jawatan sebagai Pegawai Turus Latihan Kontinjen, Ibupejabat Polis Kuala Lumpur.

Pada tahun 2003, beliau sekali lagi dinaikkan pangkat ke Deputy Superintenden Polis (DSP) dan telah ditukarkan ke Pusat Latihan Polis Kuala Lumpur (PULAPOL KL) dengan memegang jawatan sebagai Adjutan PULAPOL KL.

Berikutan itu, pada 2005, beliau telah dihantar oleh PDRM untuk melanjutkan pelajarannya di Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia dalam bidang Diploma Sains Kepolisan. Setelah tamat pengajian, beliau telah di tugaskan sebagai DSP Siasatan 1, Jabatan Siasatan Jenayah Komersial Kontinjen Polis Negeri Sembilan. Pada bulan Julai 2007 beliau dinaikkan pangkat ke Superintenden Polis (SUPT) dan memegang jawatan sebagai Ketua Jabatan Siasatan Jenayah Komersial Kontinjen Polis, Negeri Sembilan. Sejurus itu pada bulan Oktober 2015, beliau telah dinaikkan pangkat sekali lagi ke Assisten Komisioner Polis (ACP) dan menyandang jawatan sebagai Ketua Jabatan Siasatan Jenayah Komersial Kontinjen Polis, Pulau Pinang sehingga Oktober 2016.

Selanjutnya, pada bulan Oktober 2016 beliau telah diarah bertukar untuk memegang jawatan diperingkat pusat Jabatan Siasatan Jenayah Komersial (JSJK) Bukit Aman sebagai Penolong Pengarah JSJK bertanggungjawab mengendali dan memantau siasatan melibatkan kes-kes jenayah komersial yang melibatkan sektor kewangan/ perbankan/ insuran/ koperasi seluruh negara, beliau bertanggungjawab terus kepada Pengarah JSJK.

Sepanjang tempoh perkhidmatannya, beliau telah dianugerahkan “Pingat Peringatan Jasa Pahlawan Negara’ (PJPN), ‘Bintang Panglima Pasukan Polis’ (Pg.PP), ‘Bintang Pahlawan Pasukan Polis’ (PPP), ‘Pingat Ahli Mangku Negara’ (AMN), Bintang Kesatria Mangku Negara (KMN) oleh DYMM Seri Paduka Baginda Yang di-Pertuan Agong. ‘Pingat Pekerti Terpilih’ (PPT), pula merupakan anugerah daripada DYMM Yang di-Pertuan Besar Negeri Sembilan.

ACP Bersara Ramli bin Dato’ Mohd Nor telah menghadiri banyak kursus anjuran dalam dan luar negara berkaitan tugas-tugas kepolisan. Antara kursus antarabangsa yang pernah dihidirinya adalah: Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Retrainer Course di Siem Reap, Kemboja, Sydney, Australia, Manila, Philippines, Bangkok dan pada Mei 2015 di Gold Coast, Australia. Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) National Academy Graduate, 244th Session, Quantico, Virginia, USA, International Police Officer Senior Command Course, Royal Malaysia Police (RMP) College, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, Trans Border Crime, International Law Enforcement Agency Academy, Bangkok, Thailand, International Syndicated Crime Federal Bureau Investigation (FBI), USA, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, Container Cargo Handling Port of Singapore Authority (PSA), Singapore dan Conventional Cargo Handling Port of Singapore Authority (PSA), Singapore.

Dari sudut tanggungjawab sosial, beliau aktif dalam pergerakan bukan kerajaan (NGO) iaitu di dalam Persatuan Orang Asli Semenanjung Malaysia (POASM) dan kini memegang jawatan sebagai Bendari Persatuan tersebut. Beliau juga adalah seorang penggerak Dakwah Islamiah di kalangan komuniti Orang Asli Semenanjung di kawasan Cameron Highlands, Pahang dan ramai yang telah memeluk ugama Islam atas dorongan beliau. Beliau juga merupakan seorang yang akan dirujuk oleh masyarakat Orang Asli di kawasan Cameron Highlands untuk mendapat nasihat dan pandangan serta tunjuk ajar bagi menyelesaikan masalah. Beliau juga kerap diundang oleh Jabatan Kemajuan Orang Asli Malaysia (JAKOA), Agensi Kerajaan, Institusi Pendidikan, Badan Latihan dan Badan Bukan Kerajaan (NGO) untuk memberi syarahan berkaitan masyarakat Orang Asli dan juga memberi motivasi dalam program untuk masyarakat Orang Asli. Di waktu lapang nya beliau akan mengajar kelas tambahan/tuition secara percuma kepada anak-anak Orang Asli yang memerlukannya.

Profail ACP Bersara Ramli bin Dato' Mohd Nor adalah tidak lengkap jika tidak dinyatakan bersekali sumbangan ayahanda beliau Dato' Mohd Nor bin Abdullah atau 'Bah Ayob' (namanya sebelum memeluk agama Islam).

Dato' Mohd Nor bin Abdullah dilahirkan di perkampungan Orang Asli Kuala Menson, Ringlet, Cameron Highlands dan semasa darurat pertama 1946 – 1960, ketika beliau kanak-kanak telah diculik dan dibesarkan di kalangan anggota Parti Komunis Malaya (PKM) malah semasa dengan PKM beliau adalah budak suruhan Chin Peng (Setiausaha Agung PKM ketika itu). Melihat kekejaman pihak PKM yang membunuh ramai anggota keluarganya, Dato' Mohd Nor telah melarikan diri dari PKM dan memberi kerjasamanya kepada pihak pemerintah British untuk memburu dan menghapuskan saki-baki anggota PKM yang masih berada di hutan.

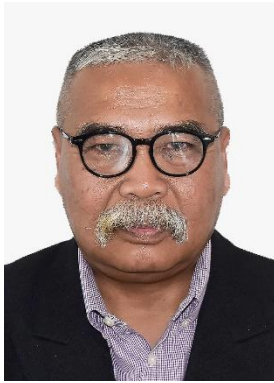
Semasa bersama pihak British Malaya, beliau adalah anggota pertama pasukan bersenjata yang dikenali sebagai 'Senoi Praaq' dan pemakaian nama Senoi Praaq bagi pasukan itu merupakan cadangan yang beliau utarakan yang dipersetujui oleh pihak British dan diguna pakai sehingga kini.

Semasa berkhidmat dengan Pasukan Polis Hutan (Senoi Praaq) PDRM dari tahun 1968 hingga 1989 (bersara), beliau telah memimpin Pasukan Senoi Praaq PDRM ini dan telah mencapai kejayaan-kejayaan seperti berikut:

1. 25 November 1973, dikawasan Gunung Camah Gob 'Ops Bamboo' – Berjaya menangkap hidup empat (4) anggota PKM (2 Lelaki & 2 Perempuan), beserta 78 Orang Asli pengikut PKM dan merampas senjata mereka. Ketika itu, kekuatan pasukan pimpinan beliau adalah Sembilan (9) orang;
2. 14 Disember 1977, dikawasan Terhong, Banding 'Ops Bamboo' – Bertempur dengan anggota PKM dan pasukannya berjaya membunuh 4 orang PKM (1 Lelaki dan 3 Perempuan) dan merampas 8 laras senjatapi. Ketika itu, kekuatan pasukan pimpinan beliau adalah Sembilan (9) orang;
3. 26 Januari 1978, dikawasan Chawong, Gunung Sepat 'Ops Bamboo' – Bertempur dalam satu serang hendap Kem PKM, kekuatan PKM lebih kurang 40 orang dan berjaya membunuh 3 orang anggota PKM (2 Lelaki dan 1 Perempuan). Ketika itu, kekuatan pasukan pimpinan beliau adalah Sembilan (9) orang; dan
4. 15 Mach 1978, dikawasan Simpor Sungai Rekom 'Ops Bamboo' telah membunuh satu anggota PKM (lelaki) dan pihak keselamatan seorang cedera sebab terkena jerangkap samar musuh. Ketika itu, kekuatan pasukan pimpinan beliau adalah Sembilan (9) orang.

Dari sudut aktiviti kemasyarakatan, beliau merupakan seorang penggerak dakwah Islamiah di kalangan masyarakat Orang Asli Cameron Highlands dan beliau sendiri telah membawa lebih 20 Orang Asli untuk memeluk agama Islam. Beliau merupakan pengasas pergerakan Umno dikalangan masyarakat Orang Asli Cameron Highlands selepas beliau bersara dari PDRM pada tahun 1989.

Beliau telah bersara daripada perkhidmatan PDRM pada tahun 1989 dengan pangkat terakhir sebagai Assistan Superintenden Polis (ASP). Atas mengenang jasa-jasa beliau kepada bangsa, Negara dan agama semasa berkhidmat dalam PDRM, DYMM Sultan Pahang telah menganugerahkan Darjah Indera Mahkota Pahang (DIMP) kepada beliau yang membawa gelaran Dato' selepas beliau bersara.

Frequently was invited by Head of Orang Asli villagers, a number of times by Jabatan Kemajuan Orang Asli Malaysia (JAKOA) and PDRM Orang Asli personnel to give motivational talk on matters of interest to Orang Asli with respect changing their mind set and way of living to a more modern and progressive life style with the aim of changing their outlook to achieve better living.

Such events in the past include during Community Policing and outreach towards the Orang Asli Community at Port Kemar in Ulu Perak and Kampung Orang Asli Peta, Mersing, Johor and Kampung Orang Asli Sungai Sungkala in Port Dickson, Negeri Sembilan.
